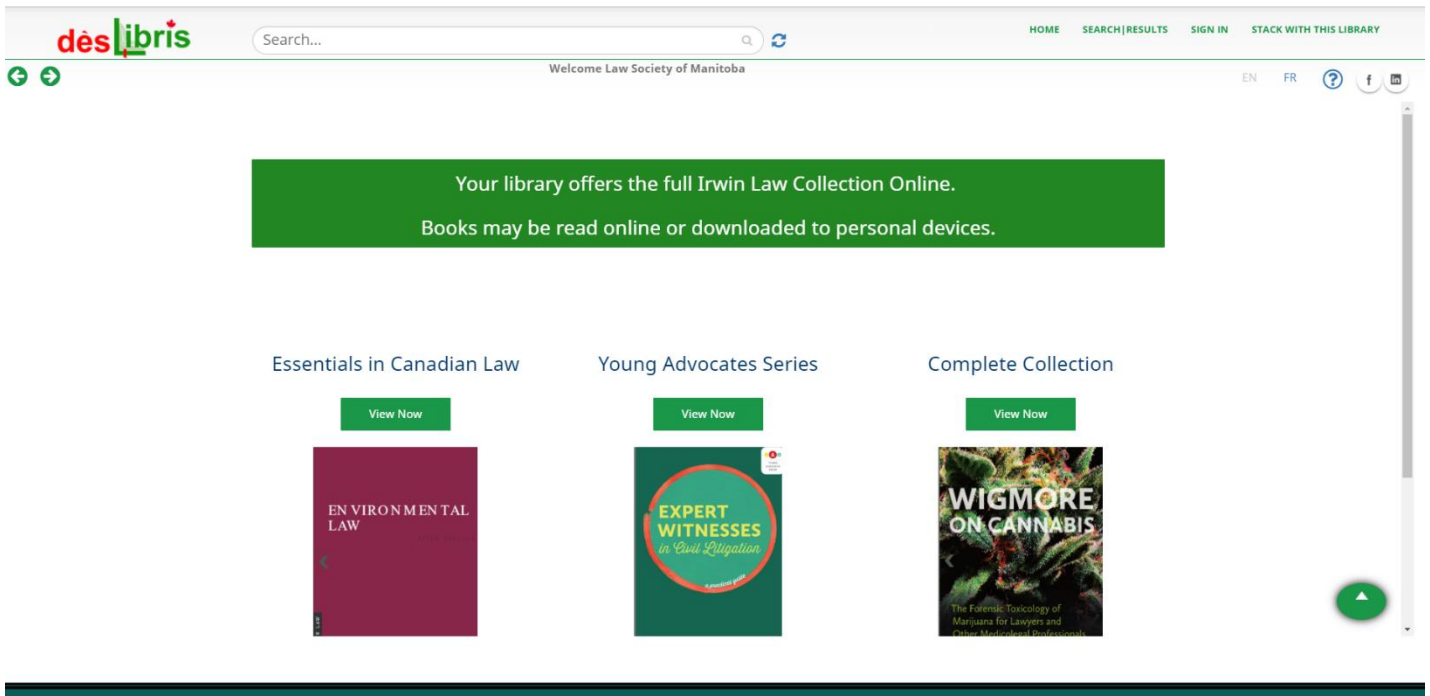
Introduction

Navigating dèsLibris

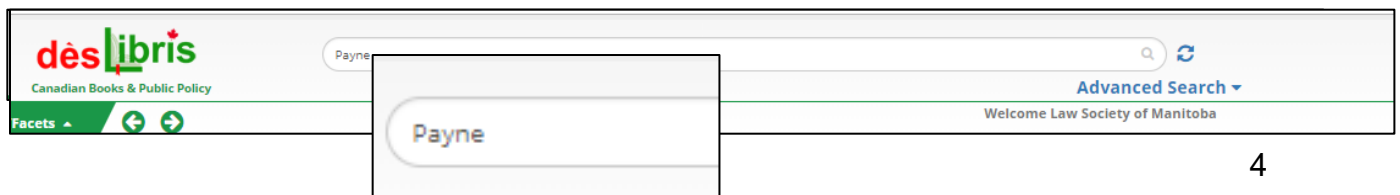
When opening dèsLibris from the Member's Portal you will land on the home screen shown below



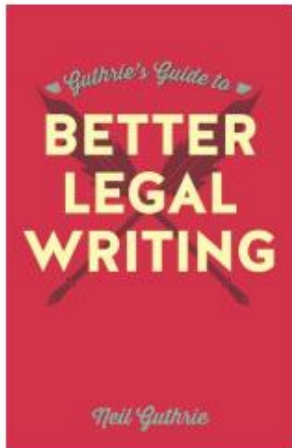

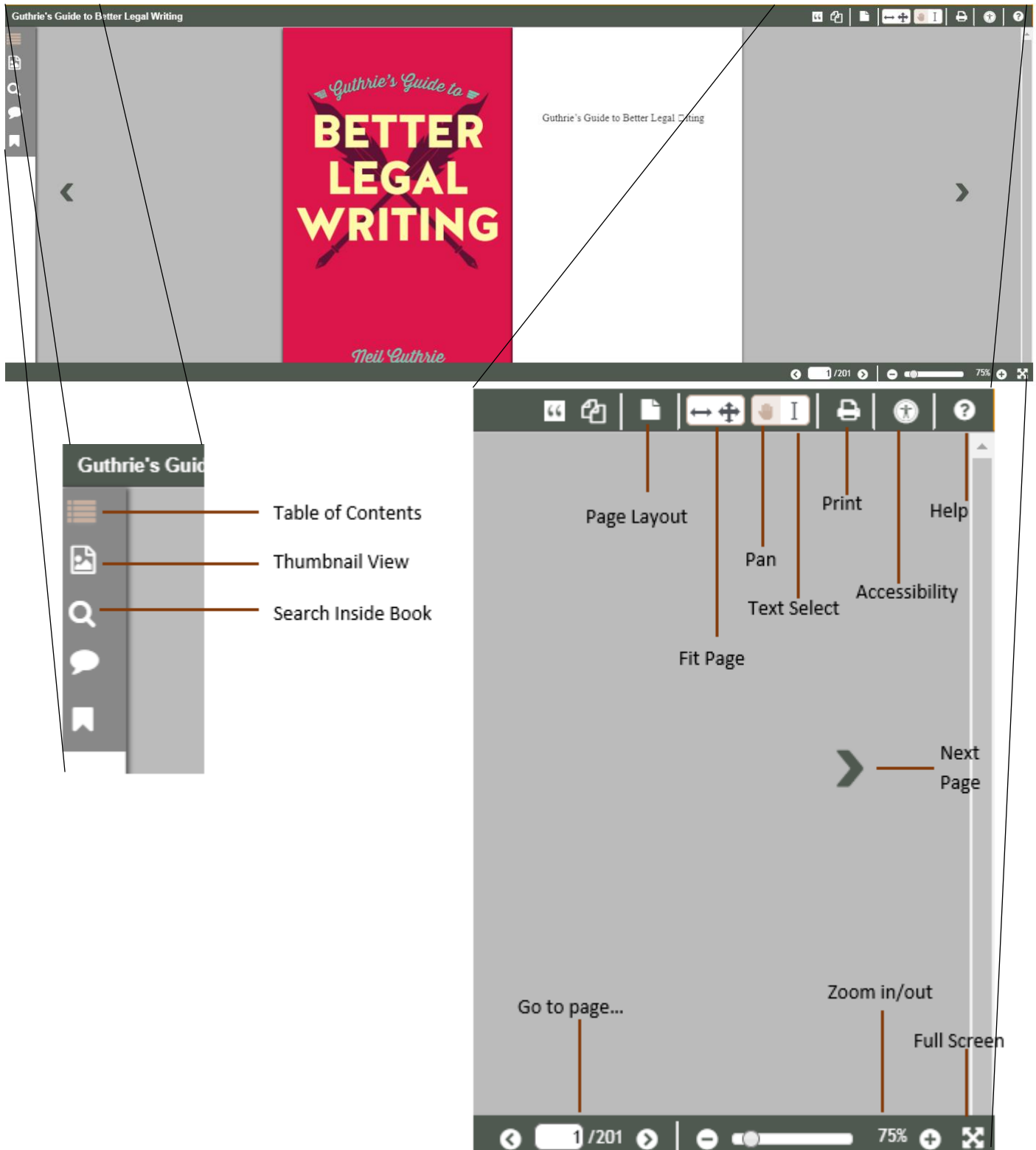
